Step 1 – Visual Check

Check the safety pin and pull tight seal are in place.

Check the extinguisher gauges are both showing in the green.

Check the extinguisher is not damaged, E.g. writing is clearly visible, no obstructions in the nozzle, the handles are not bent etc.

Wipe the extinguisher down with a plain cloth or warm water.





Step 1 – Visual Check

Locate the colour stud in the base nozzle holder to confirm year of manufacture of the extinguisher against the colour coded grid on the back to ensure it is within 10 years.




Year of Manufacture Colour Codes Stud Chart	
WHITE	2025
BLACK	2026
GREY	2027
BROWN	2028
ORANGE	2029
PURPLE	2030
YELLOW	2031
GREEN	2032
RED	2033
BLUE	2034



Step 2 – Magnet check


Remove the magnet from the base of the extinguisher.





Step 2 – Magnet check

Check both gauges with the magnet to ensure the needle moves and returns to the green.





Step 3 – Sign off

Sign the back of the unit with permanent marker to show inspection has been carried out.
